## Dual Language Methodology Facts

	Dual Language Model
<b>Pros</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ All Students Become Bilingual</li><li>✓ Encourages Inter-Dependent Learning</li><li>✓ Increased Appreciation of Cultural Diversity</li><li>✓ Addresses Social Emotional Needs</li></ul>
<b>Cons</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ High Costs / Resource Requirements</li><li>✓ Few Teachers Qualified to Teach Two-Way</li><li>✓ May Take Years for Language Proficiency</li><li>✓ Home Support is Difficult</li></ul>
<b>Cost - Financial</b>	High – Bilingual or multiple teachers, bi-lingual texts and materials
<b>Time – to Implement</b>	High – Additional staff, materials and coordination between teachers, parents and students
